The Cyprus Economy Panel will discuss the outlook of the Cyprus economy and the economic challenges going forward following the successful completion of the ESM-IMF economic adjustment programme. The outlook will focus mainly on 2017 and 2018. The challenges will focus on the state of Cyprus' public finances, the state of the banking sector and on structural reforms. The event will provide a platform for discussion and reflection on the related subjects.
